Matthew 15:18-19

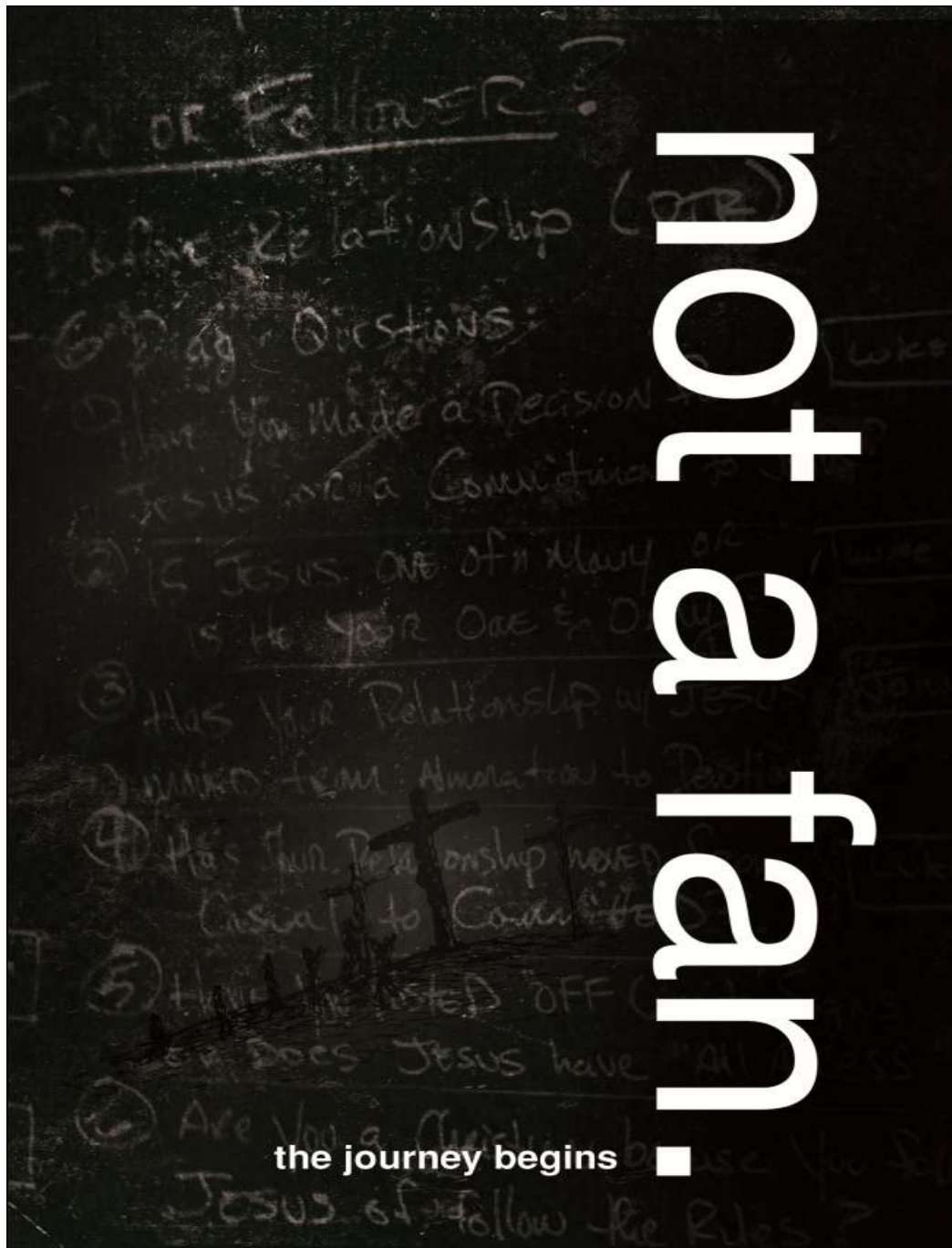
FOLLOWING JESUS MEANS FOLLOWING HIM _____
