1.	CHECK YOUR

	The right motive = TO, NOT

2.	PREPARE
	"For out of much affliction and anguish of heart I wrote to you, with many tears, not that you should be grieved, but that you might know the love which have so abundantly for you." 2 Corinthians 2:4

3.	GIVE

"A good word makes [the heart] glad" Proverbs 12:25

Begins: "I thank my God always concerning you..." 1 Corinthians 1:4

Ends: "My love be with you all in Christ Jesus." 1 Corinthians 16:24
