THE NEED FOR REPENTANT PRAYER

'penthos': holy mourning, brokenness, contrite heart

"Blessed are those who mourn, for they shall be comforted."
Matthew 5:4

ENTERING THE WASHROOM

1) ASK FOR HELP

"You do not have because you do not ask." James 4:2

2) Examine MYSELF

"for the Lord searches all hearts and understands all the intent of the thoughts." 1 Chronicles 28:9

Sins of comission & omission

3) Confess MY SINS

DIY – Do It Yourself Project #4
